## Main duties include:

- Assisting with preparation, presentation and serving of food, buffets and all

- Delivering excellent customer service and adapting as necessary to ensure that the high standard required is achieved at all services and events.
- Helping with general kitchen duties including food preparation and cleaning within the kitchen/dining room/other service areas around the school.
- Serving drinks/snacks as required and ensuring that licensing rules are followed for any age-restricted sales.
- Ensuring all areas are left clean and tidy and all waste correctly disposed, including external litter picking if required.
- Adhering to strict allergen, HSE and food safety policies and procedures
- Maintaining effective working relationships with pupils and colleagues, working collaboratively across all areas of the School.
