## Year 7 entry for September 2022

1. Should you wish to apply for a place for Year 7 entry, we recommend that you complete and return the registration form and non-refundable fee of £75 to the Admissions Department by **Friday 15 October 2021**. Registrations after this date are still accepted, however, applications for Scholarships and/or a Bursary may not be possible, dependent upon deadlines.

2. In mid-October, the school shall write to all registered applicants to invite them to attend the Entrance Assessment Day in **January 2022**.

All applicants are automatically entered for an Academic Scholarship.

Applicants will also be invited to apply for any additional Scholarships: Creative Arts, Performing Arts, Sports and Swimming. Scholarship application forms will be sent out to applicants upon request. Completed Scholarship application forms and portfolios should arrive at the school no later than **Friday 10 December 2021**. Further information regarding our Scholarships can be found in the Scholarships and Bursaries booklet.

3. Parents and guardians of registered applicants will receive an invitation in mid-October to apply for a Bursary. Should parents and guardians wish to apply for a Bursary, the reply slip should be returned promptly to the Admissions Department. The Admissions Department will provide logins to complete the online financial assessment. The deadline for completing the online financial assessment is **Tuesday 30 November 2021**. Further information regarding our Bursaries can be found in the Scholarships and Bursaries booklet.
4. On the Entrance Assessment Day, applicants will sit one Maths and one English assessment, both of which are multiple-choice papers. Applicants will have the opportunity to meet with senior staff in a group 'getting to know you' session. The remainder of the day will be spent participating in fun team-building activities. Lunch and snacks will be provided.
5. In early January, after the Entrance Assessment Day, shortlisted applicants for the Creative Arts, Performing Arts, Sports and Swimming Scholarships will be invited to attend an interview and/or practical assessment session at the school.
6. In mid-February, the school shall write to all parents and guardians to let them know if their daughter has been offered a place at the school, and if any Scholarships, and/or a Bursary, have been awarded.
7. To accept our offer of a place for their daughter, the admissions paperwork should be returned to the Admissions Department in **March 2022**.

**We hope that your daughter will be joining us in September 2022.**
