Scholarships

In mid-October, the Admissions Team shall write to all registered applicants with an invitation to the Entrance Assessment Day on Wednesday 19 January 2022. Applicants will also be invited to apply for any Scholarships; Academic, Creative Arts, Performing Arts and Sports. Entrance Assessment Day

Applicants will come into school to sit assessments in English (reading comprehension and creative writing) and Maths. Applicants will have the opportunity to meet the Head for a 'getting to know you' session before enjoying lunch with us. Those applying for an Academic Scholarship will sit the Academic Scholarship assessment (essay and non-verbal reasoning) in the afternoon.
