Mathematics is a powerful tool with a huge range of applications spanning all aspects of the curriculum. Academic

Mathematics is a popular subject at A Level. We follow the Edexcel specification covering Pure Maths, Statistics and Mechanics, allowing the students to acquire an excellent breadth and depth of skills that can be used in a wide variety of university courses.

Mathematics is recommended for students wishing to pursue a career in scientific or technical work, engineering, business studies, banking, computing and accountancy. Most teaching hospitals also accept Mathematics as a suitable qualification for entry into Medicine or Dentistry.

Co-Curricular

Students enter the individual and team challenges from the UK Maths Trust, with many winning certificates and progressing to the next rounds. We also give the students the opportunity to work with students in lower years acting as 'Number Partners'.

Our students often attend Christmas lectures at the Open University, and we offer STEP preparation classes for those considering studying at either Oxford, Cambridge and institutions employing STEP as part of their admissions process.



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
