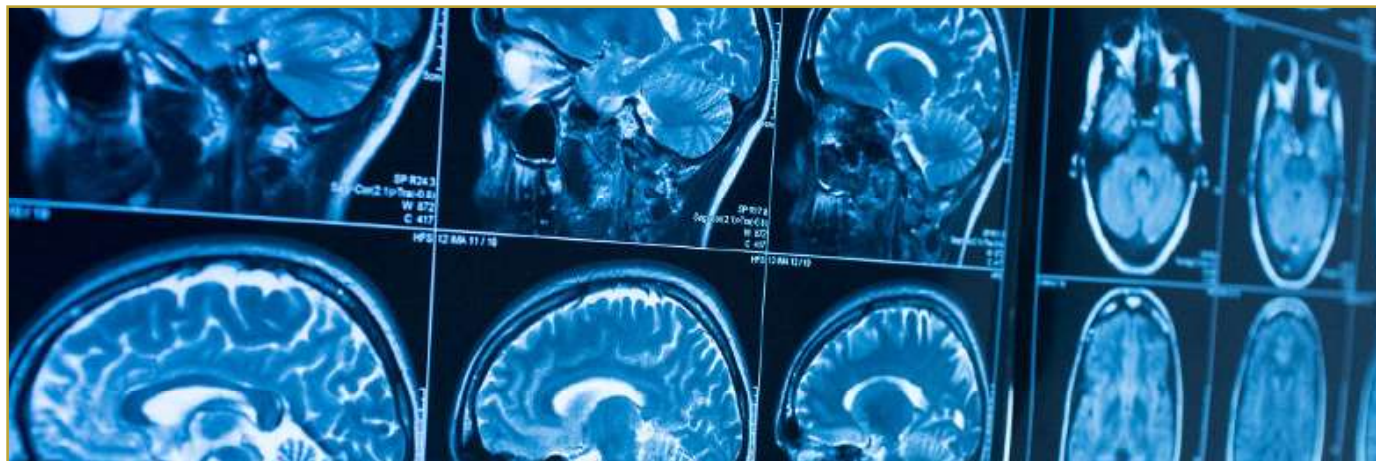


Psychology (AQA)
