Northampton High School prides itself on developing the whole person, through 360 degrees. This means we get to know our pupils for who they are as individuals and we aim to help them to achieve their dreams and ambitions.

Our cocurricular programme is one of the keys to enabling students to find their passions and to develop personally, weaving its thread through the school from the youngest pupils in Junior School to the Sixth Form. As a whole, it is made up of extracurricular clubs and activities, academic enhancement and support, the Year 10 to 13 timetabled Enrichment programme and pastoral and wellbeing schemes. In addition, we are able to take advantage of the wider Girls' Day School Trust shared and networked activities, such as GDST Limitless Learning and Masterclasses.

A key part of our overall cocurriculum is the extracurricular programme. This booklet outlines the clubs, activities and clinics available for the spring term.

The range of activities is hugely varied, encompassing sport, both competitive and recreational, music and the arts, and a great range of activities for wider interests, from debating to coding to board games clubs and more! There are also academic enrichment, extension and support clinics, and we run subject specific programmes for individuals and small groups across the full subject range.

Clubs and activities take place over the shared lunch break, where Junior School and Senior School pupils are able to work together in some cases. There are also clubs and training sessions scheduled after school. There is a late bus available which leaves at 5:15pm, and runs on Monday to Thursday.
